Equipment needed:

- Pencil (B or 2B)
- Eraser
- Music stand
- Instrument

Please do not have cell phones on or out during rehearsals.

- Saint-Saëns: *March Militaire Française* from the “Algerian Suite” (Combined with Sinfonia)
